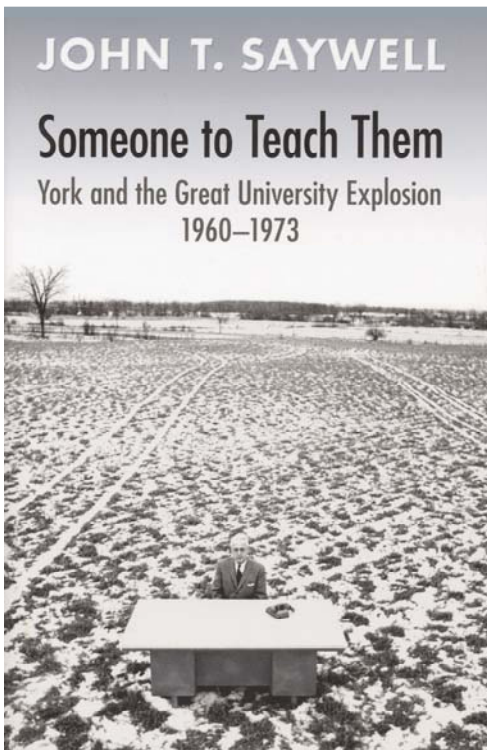

From the early 1960s to the 1970s, the province of Ontario witnessed an explosion in university enrolment. In response, a dozen new universities were established and faculty recruited wherever they could be found.

Someone to Teach Them is an insider's account of this period as told by historian John T. Saywell. As Dean of Arts at York University Saywell witnessed the expansion of the university from 500 students in 1963 to 7000 by 1970, and then the financial crisis of the early 70s. Featuring many of the elements of personal memoir, this is a thoroughly researched account of a critical decade for the history of education in Ontario.

John T. Saywell is University Professor Emeritus and Professor of History and Social Science at York University.
